**Description:** Approx 300-800 ft. Pedestrian Bridge over Coliseum Boulevard/State Road 930 between Lima Road and Speedway Drive – Request for Proposals will be advertised by INDOT in mid-December to hire consultants for PE, NEPA and ROW Services. Topographic survey should begin in the spring of 2023. NEPA and PE will take place in 2023 and 2024 with ROW Acquisition in 2025. If funds are secured, the bridge could be constructed in 2026 at the earliest.
