Pufferbelly Trail: from State Boulevard to Fernhill Avenue (DES# 0710990)

Project Description

The trail will begin on the north side of State Boulevard and extend north along a former railroad corridor to Fernhill Avenue. A ten-foot wide trail spur will be constructed from the mainline of the trail to Franke Park and Franke Park Elementary School.

The preliminary engineering phase of this project began in 2010. The right of way phase began in 2014. The letting date has been set for February 8, 2017, construction will begin in the spring of 2017. This project is being funded through the Transportation Alternative Project (TAP) fund.
