

Auburn Road: Cook Road to Clinton Street

(DES# 0710495 & 0400581)

Project Description

The intersection improvements on Auburn Road are from Clinton Street to just north of Cook Road. The improvements include turn lanes on all approaches, 5' sidewalk on west side of Auburn Road, 8' trail on east side of Auburn Road and south side of Cook Road, street lights, and a new signal at the intersection of Auburn Road and Cook Road.

The preliminary engineering began in 2009. Additional funding for preliminary engineering was added for 2010. Right of way acquisition began in 2010. The construction phase of this project is scheduled to begin in the Spring of 2012. This project is being funded through the Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) fund and Surface Transportation Program (STP).

The following is the cost breakdown for the Auburn Road intersection improvement project.
