

Covington Road & Dicke Road Intersection

(DES# 0810288)

Project Description

Intersection improvements to Covington Road and Dicke Road include additional turning lanes. The improvements to this intersection will also allow signalization to be added in the future when needed. An 8' trail will be added on the northside of Covington Road to connect with future trails along Covington Road. This project will occur in conjunction with the State of Indiana's project to replace the Covington Road bridge over Interstate 69 (DES# 0710927).

Preliminary engineering for this project began in 2009. Right of way acquisition began in 2011 and the construction phase is scheduled for the fall of 2012. The intersection improvements are being funded through the Surface Transportation Program (STP) and Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ).

The following is the cost breakdown for the Covington Road & Dicke Road intersection improvement project.
