

I-69 at SR1 (Dupont Road)

Interchange Modification

(DES# 0901298)

Project Description

The I-69 and SR 1 (Dupont Road) interchange will be modified from a traditional diamond interchange to a Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI). The DDI modification will take Dupont Road traffic to the left side of the roadway as it crosses the bridge between the I-69 northbound and southbound ramps. Once on the left side of Dupont Road, vehicles can turn left onto the interchange ramps without stopping and without conflicting with through traffic.

The preliminary engineering phase will be done in 2012 and construction is scheduled for 2013. Construction will not take place until after the interchange at I-69 and Union Chapel Road is open.
