

Johnny Appleseed Trail (Phase Ib)

IPFW Pedestrian Bridge to Upper St. Joe Center Road
(DES# 0900018)

Project Description

This phase begins at the IPFW pedestrian bridge. It then continues north along the historic St. Joseph feeder canal of the Wabash and Erie Canal until it reaches St. Joe Center Road. At St. Joe Center Road, the trail will go under the bridge to continue north along Upper St. Joe Center Road, where this phase ends.

The preliminary engineering began in 2009. The right of way phase of this project began in 2010. Construction is scheduled to begin in 2012. This project is being funded through the Transportation Enhancement (TE) fund.
