

# Landin Road: North River Road to Maysville Road

(DES# 0710319)

## Project Description

This is a roadway widening project. Landin Road will be widened to 12' lanes in each direction and a 14' two way left turn lane from 225' north of North River Road to Trier/Maysville Road. The project also consists of drainage improvements with curb and gutter section and 8' sidewalks on both sides of the road. The City of New Haven has decided to include a water main extension with this project, which will be funded with local money. The Water line will run along the west side of Landin Road from the south limits of the project to the north service boundary at Parent Road then continuing east along the south side of Parent Road to the project limits.

The preliminary engineering phase of this project began in 2010. The right of way phase is scheduled to begin in 2012, with construction scheduled for 2015. The funding for this project is provided through the Surface Transportation Program (STP).

The following is the cost breakdown for the Landin Road project.
