Project Description

The New Haven Depot and Corridor Project involves the historic restoration of the New Haven Depot in downtown New Haven. The project will also involve trail improvements along three blocks of Main Street connecting the Depot to the New Haven Trail System at Moser Park and to the downtown.

The preliminary engineering phase of this project has begun (2009). The right of way phase and the construction of this project is scheduled to begin in 2011. This project is being funded through the Transportation Enhancement (TE) program.
