

New York Central Railroad Corridor Acquisition

Project Description

This project is the acquisition of the right of way from the old New York Central rail line. The old New York Central runs between Lima Road (SR 3) to the west, and Coldwater Road to the east. The land that is being acquired is between Washington Center Road on the south and Wallen Road to the north. The acquisition of this land will be used to construct a multi-use trail.

The preliminary engineering began in 2009. The right of way acquisition phase of this project is scheduled to begin in 2011. The construction phase of this project is not scheduled at this time. Additional funding will be needed to complete this project. This project is being funded through the Transportation Enhancement (TE) program.

The following is the cost breakdown for the Railroad Corridor Acquisition project.
