

Pufferbelly Trail: Dupont Road to Carroll Road

Project Description

This section of the Pufferbelly Trail will be a 10'-12' wide multi-use trail. The Pufferbelly Trail is part of the State Visionary Trail that will connect Pokagon State Park with Ouabache State Park. As this project develops more descriptive information will be added.

The preliminary engineering phase of this project began in 2011. The right of way phase is scheduled to begin in 2012. Construction is scheduled for 2013. The federal funding of this project is from the Recreational Trails Program (RTP) fund.
