

Spring Street: Bridge over Norfolk Southern Railroad at Leesburg Road

Project Description

This project contains many different components. Along with the bridge over the railroad being replaced, improvements to the Spring Street and Leesburg Road intersection will also be done. Intersection improvements include the addition of a westbound left-turn lane on Spring Street and a northbound right-turn lane on Leesburg Road. Signalization of the intersection and installation of bike lanes on the bridge and along Spring Street to Leesburg Road will be included in the project.

The right of way phase of this project began in 2010. The construction of the bridge is scheduled for 2011. The funding for this project is being provided through the Surface Transportation Program (STP) and the Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) program.

The following is the cost breakdown for the Spring Street bridge project.
