

State Road 1: I-69 to Tonkel Road

(DES# 9700220, 0200884, 990022A, 990022X)

Project Description

The proposed project will include three 12' lanes in each direction from I-69 to Diebold Road, after which it will narrow to two lanes in each direction. A dedicated left turn lane will be included at major intersections and a bidirectional left turn lane will be throughout the rest of the project. Curb and gutter will be installed throughout the project and upgrades will be made to the existing signals, but no new signals are planned at this time. Sidewalks will be placed on the north side, from Tonkel Road east to Oak Chapel Drive, as well as on the south side, from east of Tonkel Road to Tokheim Corporation Driveway.

Project Update

At the end of August traffic was switched to the north so that construction on the south side of Dupont Road could begin. The 2009 construction season will include embankment construction and excavation work at Martin Ditch and near the Dupont Estates Mobile Home Park. After that construction is complete, temporary asphalt widening work will begin on the same side of the road. Utility work will continue this fall. By Thanksgiving, traffic should be switched to the new temporary asphalt widened area. Once traffic is switched, similar construction will take place on the north side of Dupont Road. The project will be complete in the summer of 2011. This project is being funded through the American Recovery & Reinvestment Act (ARRA).

The following is the cost breakdown for the State Road 1 added travel lanes project.
