

State Boulevard: Spy Run Avenue to Cass Street

(DES# 0400587)

Project Description

This project includes the replacement of the bridge over Spy Run Creek and a prefabricated crossing over State Boulevard for the Pufferbelly Trail along the old railroad right of way. In addition to this there will also be added travel lanes in both directions of State Boulevard. A portion of State Boulevard will have a center turn lane, a landscaped median will also be installed where needed.

The preliminary engineering for the project began in 2009. Right of way is scheduled for 2011. The funding for this project is being provided through the Surface Transportation Program (STP).

The following is the cost breakdown for the State Boulevard project.
