

State Boulevard: Clinton Street to Cass Street (Phase 2)

(DES #1005154; kin to #0400587)

Project Description

This is the construction of the second phase of the State Boulevard project from Spy Run to Cass Street. In this phase, travel lanes will be added in both directions of State Boulevard. A portion of State Boulevard will have a center turn lane, a landscaped median will also be installed where needed. In addition to the added travel lanes the bridge over Spy Run Creek will be replaced and a pedestrian bridge will be constructed over State Boulevard for the Pufferbelly Trail.

The second phase of construction for this project is scheduled to begin in 2014. The funding for this project is being provided through the Surface Transportation Program (STP). The local share will be split between the City of Fort Wayne and Allen County. The County will pay \$360,000 of the local share, this is for the replacement of the bridge over Spy Run Creek. (Allen County is responsible for all bridge projects.)

The following is the cost breakdown for the State Boulevard project.
