## Project Description

This project includes road reconstruction and realignment of Wayne Trace from Pontiac Street to Oxford Street will include new pavement, lane widening to three lanes with a center left-turn lane. In addition to these road improvements a new sidewalk on the east side of Wayne Trace and new street lights will all be included.

Construction is complete for this project. The funding for this project was provided through the Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) program.
