



## CITILINK BUS, ACCESS & CAMPUSLINK

Citilink operates fixed and point deviation **Bus** service, **Access** for those who are physically unable to utilize the bus service, and **Campuslink** for the Ivy Tech / IPFW area.


 Monday through Friday from 5:45am to 9:45pm & Saturday from 7:45am to 6:30pm. Buses operate every 30 or 60 minutes. Pre-registration and qualification are required for ACCESS, as well as advanced reservations by 5:00pm the day before travel.


 Service Area: The Cities of Fort Wayne and New Haven

**\$\$** **BUS:** \$1.25 each way. \$3 Day Pass, \$45 31-Day Pass. Half fares are offered for seniors, children and persons with disabilities.

**ACCESS:** \$2.50 each way. Friends and family may ride as space provides for \$2.50. Attendant rides free.

**CAMPUSLINK:** Free 5-20 minute frequency shuttle service serving the IvyTech/IPFW area students, faculty, staff & general public.


 All vehicles are fully accessible. ACCESS provides curb to curb assistance.
